## Federal Level (Laws and Orders)



*The Phasing out of the Swiss nuclear production was decided on 21.05.2011 after the Fukushima nuclear disaster.*



- 38,8 TWh/y of nuclear consumption should be removed from 2013 to 2034
- Increase renewable energies from 1,6 to 23,5 TWh/y from 2011 to 2050

***“ We are not convinced regarding the complete opening of the electricity market, forecasted by 2018, in Switzerland. Why could it generate financial gains to the clients ? ”***

- How could we separate electricity activities from other fluid ones, which are together, now without generating cost increases?
- How could we invest and promote renewable energies to clients, such as solar, wind, geothermal or biomass ones, with an open-market to get energy at lowest prices?
- Who is going to pay for special IT equipment, such as smart meters or local smart grids, for client changes of energy marketers or for proliferation of local renewable energy productions?

***“ We think that, in Switzerland, the open-market is difficult to match with a strategy promoting the mass development of renewable energies at that level of TWh/y .”***
